

WHEN CAN A STUDENT OR EMPLOYEE RETURN TO SCHOOL?

THE SCHOOL WILL FOLLOW THIS FLOWCHART TO DETERMINE WHEN A PERSON CAN RETURN TO CAMPUS

IF YOU HAVE...

A LAB CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19

Persons with COVID-19 compatible symptoms or people who tested positive for COVID-19 should stay home until at least 10 days have passed since onset of symptoms

AND

No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicines

AND

Other symptoms have improved.

Persons who test positive for COVID-19, but who are *asymptomatic*, should stay home for 10 days from the positive test result.

Contact the public health officer in your town for further guidance.

ONE OR MORE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

Clearance note from your primary physician and a negative COVID-19 test or at least 10 days have passed since the onset of symptoms

AND

No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicines

AND

Other symptoms have improved.

No one will be permitted on school grounds with a pending COVID-19 test.

HAVE BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT WITH A LAB CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19

Based on medical guidelines, if you have been in close contact with a COVID-19 positive person (within 6 feet, for 15 minutes or more, during a 24 hour period), you should self-quarantine for 14 days from the last date of exposure.

Contact your doctor for further guidance.

If you test positive for COVID-19, follow the guidelines for A LAB CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19.

TRAVELED FROM A STATE THAT IS CURRENTLY ON THE TRAVEL ADVISORY LIST

Return to school only after you have completed the appropriate self-quarantine. See NJ guidelines for out-of-state travel.
